VIII. Committee Reports

a. Concessions – Abida and Monique

- i. Abida wants us to think about how we can get more support from students/staff/etc. to support Boosters throughout the year. Monique tried to work with coaches last year to facilitate student involvement, but to no avail. Will meet with Jessica and others.
- ii. Monique updated all the binders and there have been big improvements. We'd like to start using lockboxes for concession keys so that we don't have to look for Mr. Carlson (he supports this). I'd like to get a reaction from Taff and Stephanie before moving forward. Once everyone has signed off on the lockbox, Monique can move forward with finalizing the binders and training videos. Wants training videos done by winter sports season.
- iii. We'd like to request budget approval for the following items:
 - 1. Lockboxes (2): \$70
 - 2. Coffee Maker: \$50
 - 3. Misc Expenses: \$50 (printing, laminating sheets, binders)
These costs would come out of concessions budget.
Asking for ~\$200 total – approved by board.

b. Raider Wear and Yard Signs – Nancy

Wants to get more Raider Wear for playoffs- more red t-shirts, a few gray hoodies, trying to get mock-ups and prices for trucker hats and beanies, maybe more PJs (for the holidays), flags, zip-up fleece hoodie.
Will get the price from her vendor and let us know the cost for board approval.
We want to give a flag to LeweyQs and Ellyn's, but we could ask other businesses.
Holidays- last year, we had "special" items for the holiday shop; this year, if our

vendor can do orders on demand, that may be a better way to go so people can get the sizes they want. In the past, orders were through Boosters and we handled disseminating the items, but if the vendor would prefer to do it themselves, that's fine. Nancy will work on this next week.

First home basketball game- girls 11/28 first home game; boys 11/30 first boys home game (D87 tournament at GBW 11/20)

Maybe set up 12/7 Joint choir/orchestra concert at 7:30pm

We sold a bunch of hand warmers at the last football game (\$2)- will get more for any cold playoff games

Joyce at the church- \$360 for the room (Large room, kitchen, custodial fee)- needs check for that

Has a case of wine being donated by Carey Fredrick

Needs Bingo prizes and auction prizes- sports-related, school items (Jessica said to repeat what did last time and send to her; use expiration date by end of April for some things)

Stephanie may have some gift cards left from last year and Nikki may have some items that came in after the golf outing

Volunteers/committee will work on acquisitions, too

Will have keepsake wineglass for all attendees
